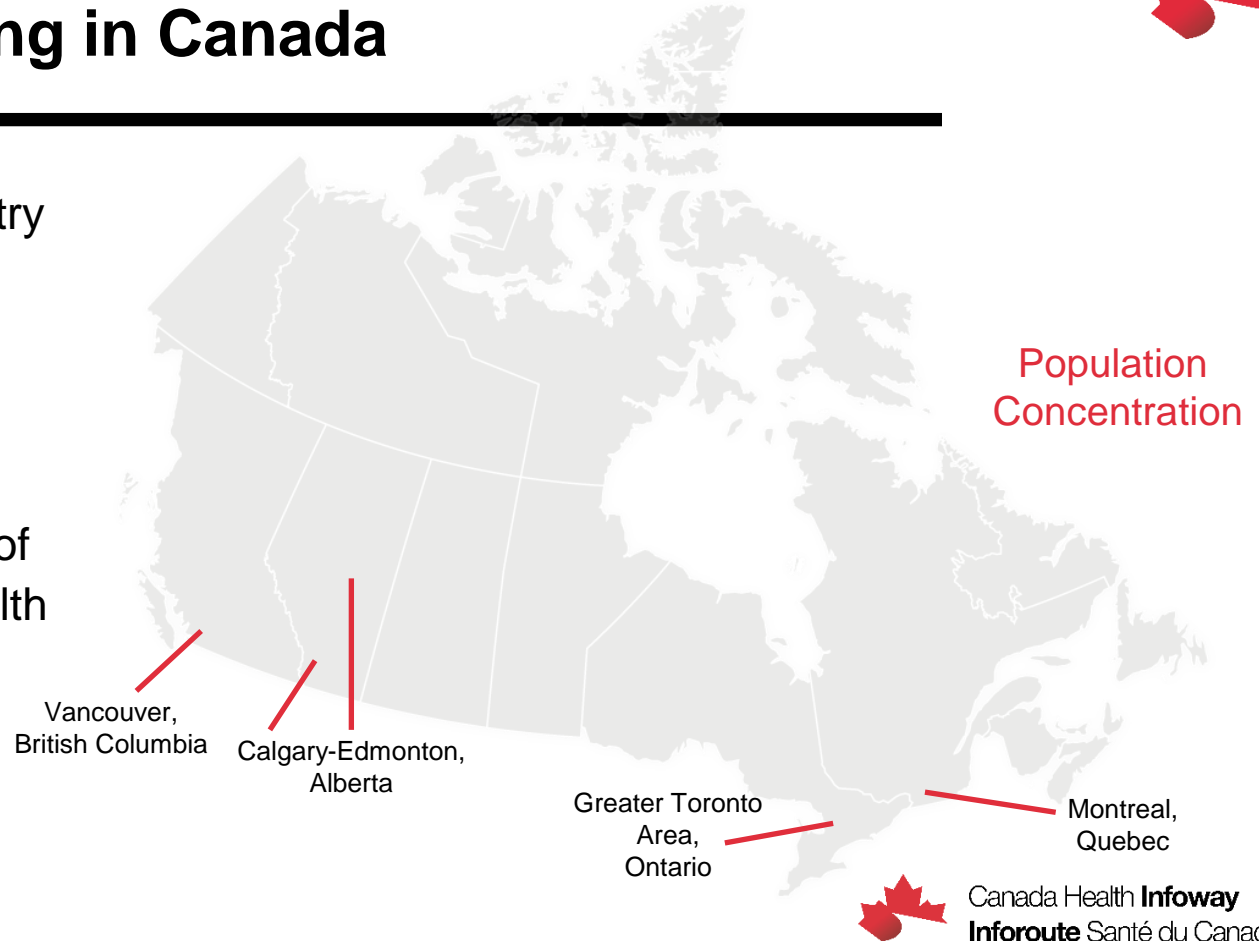

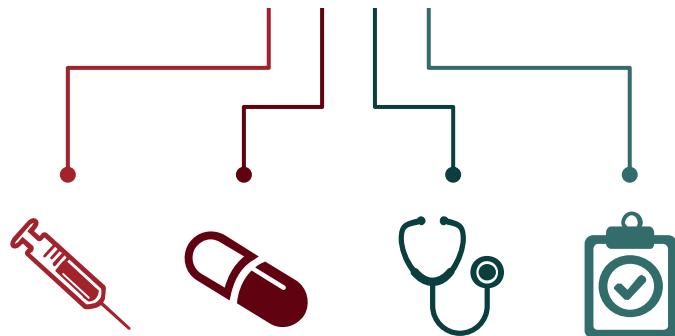


Health Spending in Canada

 - 11.3% of GDP



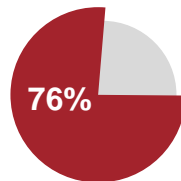
Canadians Overwhelmingly Want Digital Health Solutions That Enhance Access to Care



Meeting National Demand for Digital Health Solutions – Understanding the Challenge

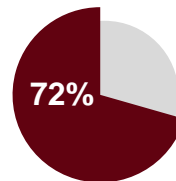

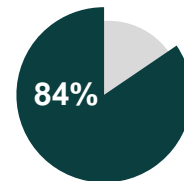

ACCESS Health Program



Infoway's ACCESS Health program is uniting industry, health care providers, provinces, territories and Canadians to redefine where and how Canadians access care.





ACCESS Health: Key Attributes



Provides Digital Health Infrastructure

- ACCESS Health will provide the digital enablement, on a pan-Canadian basis, of the five principles of the *Canada Health Act*
- The ACCESS Gateway will provide the core infrastructure Canadians require to bring together their health information from disparate sources and enable citizens to control who sees their data via a consent solution



Sets Rules of Engagement Under a Trust Framework

- Users of ACCESS Gateway must agree to participate under established rules
- "Certification" includes a common agreement and formal onboarding process to ensure conformity to information-sharing principles
- Protects patient health information from misuse; data will not be sold or used for marketing or promotional purposes
- Managing consent to use patient health data is a high priority for ACCESS Health



Drives Economies of Scale

- The ACCESS Gateway will enable solutions to be certified and connect once but be implemented multiple times on a jurisdiction by jurisdiction basis. This will drive cost-savings and further increase innovation in Canadian healthcare
- ACCESS Health will provide private sector solution/service providers with the tools to scale their solutions – a function that no one single private sector player can achieve on its own



Drives Innovation and Market Growth

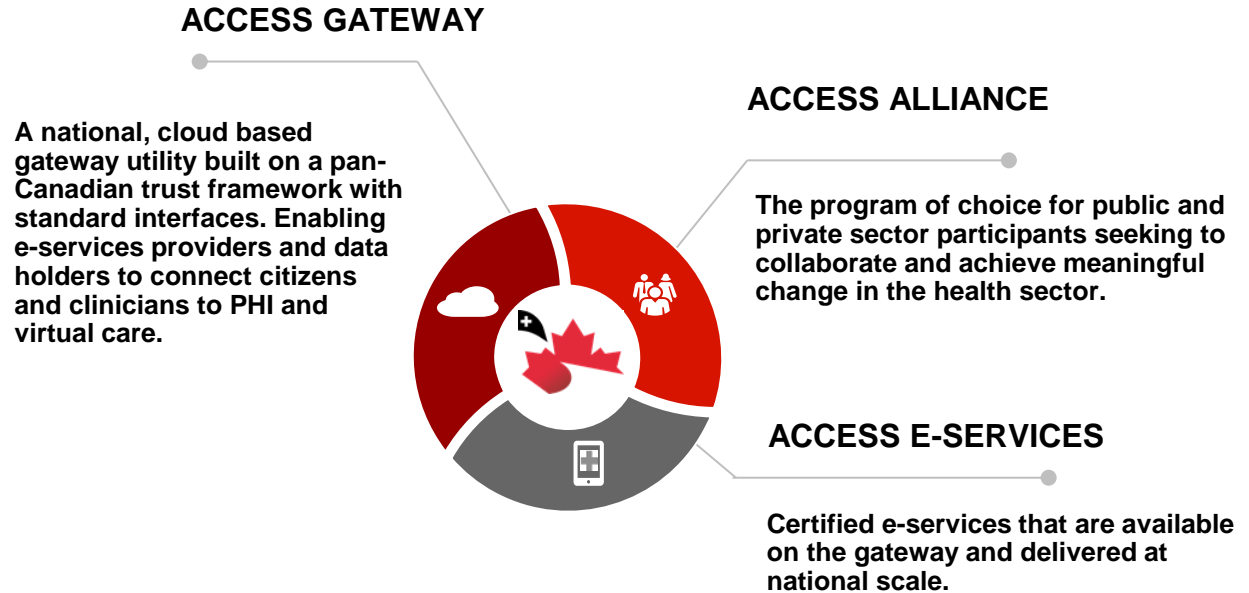
- Through ACCESS Gateway, Infoway will provide APIs and consent/identity management services to application developers who want to integrate and scale their product offerings
- Current efforts are focused on supporting products that need citizen identity/consent management, access to personal health information, and/or access to service directory/personal health information (e.g. lab test results, medication profile, and immunization)
